Lang & Reed 2009 Cabernet Franc - 'Two-Fourteen' - Napa Valley

"Tart cassis and currant jam flavors fill this rich red, franc in its firm, stemmy-green highlights, Napa in its juicy dark fruit and French-oaked, cacao-nib tannins. Dark mineral edges emerge from those tannins with air, revealing the focus of a wine grown on volcanic rock. This is named for clone 214, which originated in the Loire, now farmed at Sugarloaf Mountain in Southeastern Napa Valley."
