This is a sexy, mid-weight wine with loads of blueberry and raspberry fruit, some floweriness, medium body and beautiful purity, texture and length. It is not a blockbuster by any means, but it is wonderfully well-done and delicious. Drink it over the next 7-8 years.

This winery has been long practicing with Cabernet Franc and was one of the first to bottle 100% Cabernet Franc from a vineyard in Napa. They use a Loire Valley clone and source it from the Sugarloaf Mountain Vineyard, which some readers may be familiar with as a source for some of the great red wines being made by Russell Bevan.
